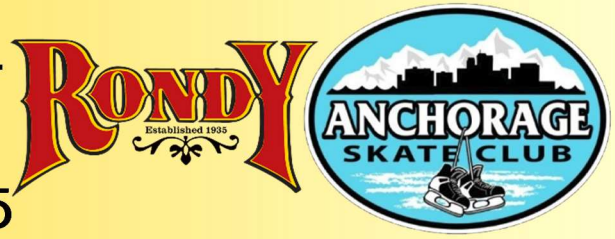

TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES

The spirit of this event is one of fair play and fun. There is little tolerance for overly aggressive play and zero-tolerance for fighting. Any player cited for three penalties in one game or fighting will be ejected from the tournament.

1. This is a multi-level tournament. The 5 divisions of play (Open, Intermediate/Novice, 45+, Women and Youth) will have registration restricted to 8 teams per each division.
2. Tournament format for each division is preliminary round pool play with 2 teams advancing to a final game.
3. Game format is three – fifteen minute – running time periods. Tie games will be decided by 5 minute running time sudden death period. If still undecided, a five player shoot-out will follow. If tie persists, a “sudden-death” shoot-out takes place. One shooter from each team shoots until one scores and the other does not. No shooter can repeat until all of his teammates have shot (except the goalie).
4. Slap-shots are allowed in the open division only; all other levels are no-slap shot.
5. Specific rules for women’s division game play will be determined by officials.
6. Awards will be presented to the champions of each division.

MANAGER GUIDELINES

1. Each manager is responsible for his or her team member’s conduct.
2. Each manager is responsible for making sure all of his/her players have signed the waiver of liability form. Any team found with a player or players in a game without a signed waiver will be disqualified and ejected from the tournament. No refund will be issued.
3. Each manager is responsible for the nonrefundable entry fee.
